1_year CONVERSION PROGRAMME
for those with prior diploma in nursing

Requirements:

- Certified vocational Diploma or Certificate in nursing
- Work certificate, minimum 2 years as a registered nurse
- English skills (interview)
- Good health

Compulsory pre-orientation training
online (Finnish language) before vocational training:
3 months/ 300 hours, target level A1.3 (CEFR)

Tuition first in English and progressively in Finnish. Compulsory practical exams taken in Finnish to acquire Finnish nursing registration after graduation.

Group size 25 participants.

The Vocational Qualification in Social and Health Care is composed of vocational units (145 competence points) and common units (35 competence points). The scope of a vocational qualification is 180 competence points.

The qualification includes four compulsory units:

- Promotion of growth and social inclusion
- Promotion of wellbeing and functional capacity
- Care and rehabilitation for elderly people
- Nursing and care

The common units are: Communication and interaction skills, Competence in mathematics and natural sciences, and Society and working life skills.

Work tasks that can be executed

- different tasks in nursing and care
- services for the elderly and persons with disabilities
- basic health care and specialized medical care
- jobs may be found in the public, private, or third sector

Edusampo services include: Tuition on campus and all learning materials, language lessons online (if applicable) and on the job learning in the workplace

Not included: Travel, accommodation, insurance, landing services, laptop
